Dear friends.

My name is Fr Dang Nguyen. You have been informed that I have recently been appointed by Archbishop Mark Coleridge to serve at Acacia Ridge Parish. I would like to take this opportunity to write few words to introduce myself.

I am originally from Vietnam. I was born and raised in the countryside. I am a middle child of five in a loving and devoted Catholic family. Both of my parents are farmers and my whole childhood was closely connected with rice and sugar cane farms.

My parents brought me up well and also instilled and nourished my faith. I still remember that my family often prayed rosary together during the evening. To be honest, I once thought that was the worst thing that a parent can do to their child . However, looking back now, I believe that the experience gave me both a sense of faith and this kindled my love for the priesthood vocation.

However, not until late 2008, I came and joined the priesthood formation with the Augustinians in Sydney that my childhood dream became a reality. After ten years of religious formation, I was ordained on the 22nd September 2018 by Archbishop Mark Coleridge. I was then assigned as an Associate Pastor of St James Parish until mid of 2019, then briefly at the Cathedral of St Stephen, Caloundra and Jubilee. Even though, I have been ordained only four and a half year ago, I am very fortunate that I have been serving in a number of parishes. The best part of the experience is that I have come to know so many wonderful people who have incredible faith.


They not only taught me what it means to be a priest, but also have helped me to grow in my relationship with God.
