It is official now we are a growing parish and we need to look at the infrastructure that will cater for the growth as we move into the future.

Like any parish, we need to restore and maintain our building facilities. Examples:

- \* the walls and ceilings need cleaning; it is very unhygienic for us all to be breathing in the years of built up dust.
- \* We have over 200 youth regularly using the Blue Hall, which needs work done to ensure it is safe




# Youth Coordinator Sponsorship Programme.




