
#### APPOINTMENT OF BISHOP KEN HOWELL

We look forward to the Installation on 11 July, and in the meantime we accompany Bishop Ken with our prayers.



### Referendum on The Voice 2023

I was struck by a huge page in the Courier Mail on Saturday 27th May. It was a full-page spread, signed by the various leaders of Australia's sporting bodies, all supporting a positive response to the Referendum on the Yes vote planned by the Australian Government to take place later in the year.

I have placed a copy at the door of our Church for you to see and copies can be available for those who wish to read it as well. I hope I have not infringed copyright by so doing.

I mention this here, because a week or two ago, I attended a clergy gathering addressing this very issue. Two leaders of our First Nations People spoke to us of the importance of the YES vote for the future of First Nations People and their place in our Land Australia.

Unfortunately, there was no representation from the 'NO' side of the argument, but I was struck by the plea from the two Indigenous people who did speak, and it seems to me that in voting Yes for First Nations Peoples to be included in Australia's Constitution and by giving them a voice to Parliament when it comes to issues affecting First Nations Peoples it can only be a good thing, not only for them but for us as Australian People together.

The Referendum later in the year, is a conscience vote for all Australians, but hopefully the outcome of this referendum will give our Indigenous brothers and sisters a place at the table of decisions.

It seemed to me that the leadership of our significant sporting bodies through this full-page spread, have offered their support for a YES vote when the time comes, but the decision is ours.

May we choose wisely and well in this important decision for our Land and its people.
